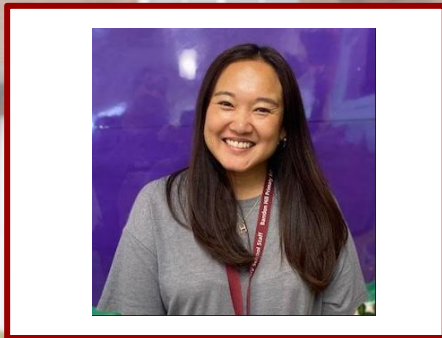

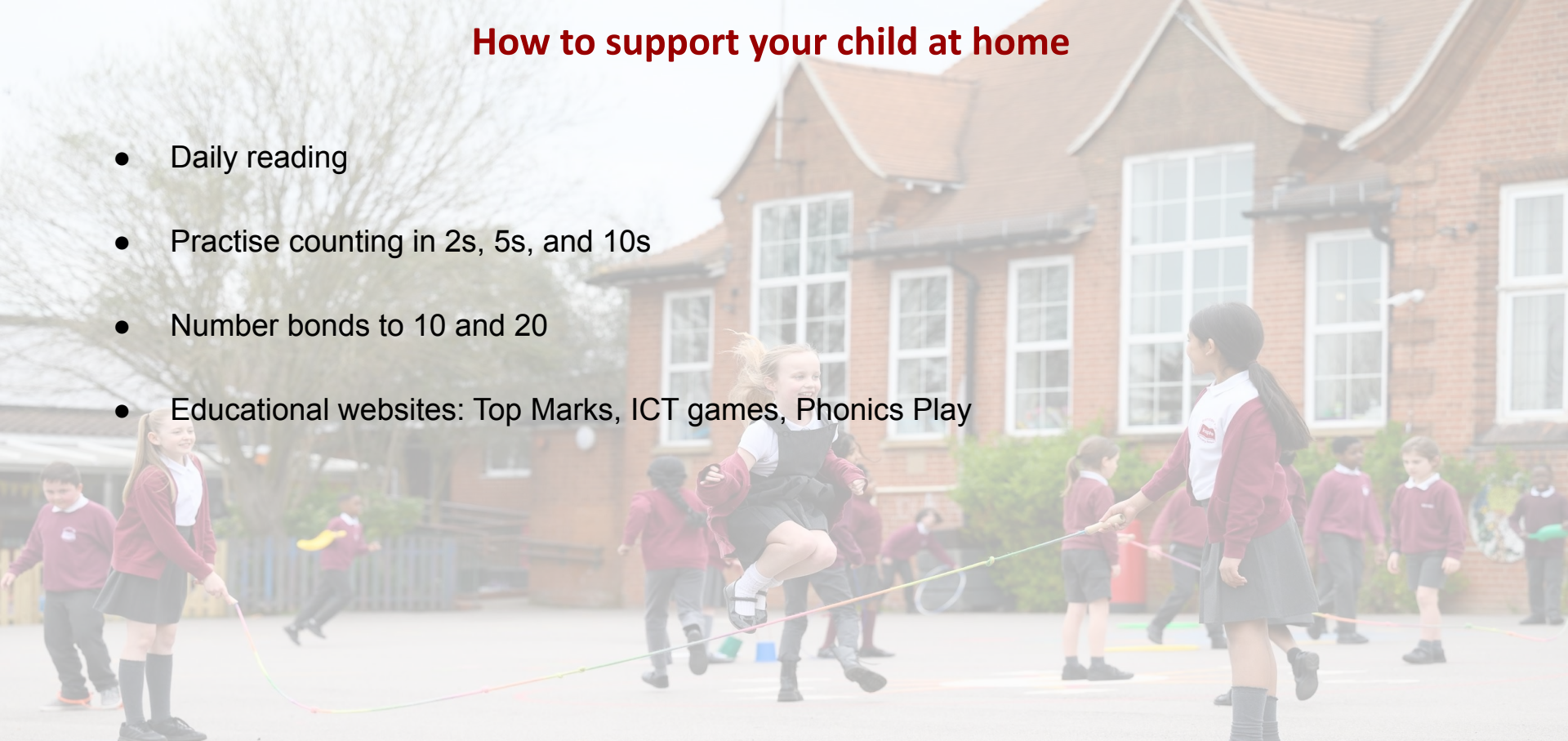

- Office will call if they deem parent or carer communication to be necessary

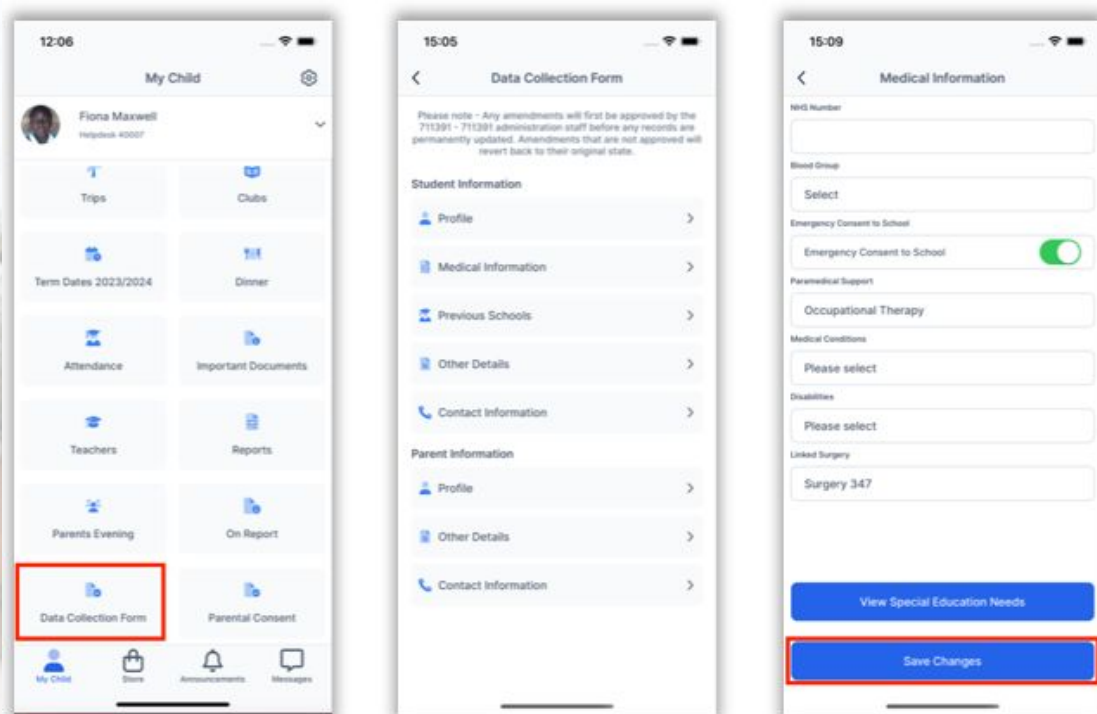


Go to My Child then either click on Data Collection Form.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Children are required by law to attend school 190 days per year. The Government states that every pupil's attendance should be at least 95%.

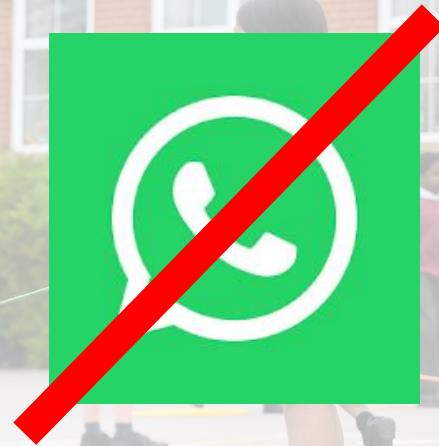

Use of Technology

- **Devices:** We use Chromebooks for Computing lessons and Cross Curricular lessons too. Passwords and usernames will be found in your child's communication book
- **Internet Safety:** Guidelines on safe internet use can be found on the school website. All classes will be teaching explicit Internet Safety lessons during the first two weeks of the academic year.
- **Online Presence:** We recommend children not using the internet unsupervised. Apps such as Whatsapp should not be accessed by children at Bandon Hill Primary School as the minimum age to use the service is 13.
