New Toilet Facilities for Years 3, 4, 5 & 6

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are absolutely delighted to share some fantastic news regarding upcoming improvements to our school site.

Listening to our children is incredibly important to us, and following direct feedback from the children requesting an upgrade to the existing toilets, we are investing in brand-new toilet facilities for our Key Stage 2 children (Years 3, 4, 5, and 6). We are so excited to deliver this development for them.

To ensure that these substantial works are fully completed and ready for use by September, the project will need to begin during the upcoming summer term. We have planned this carefully to ensure there is minimal impact on the daily running of the school.

Current Building Works Update

First, we have some great news about our ongoing site works. These will be completed by the second week of this term, which means we will very soon have much more of our playground available for the children to enjoy.

Key Arrangements for the rest of the Summer Term

While the new toilets are being constructed, a temporary toilet block will be installed on the playground. These will be plumbed into the ground to replicate the existing toilet facilities we have in the KS2 corridor. To keep our daily routines running safely and smoothly, please make note of the following arrangements:

- **Children's Assembly:** Mr. Haddock will lead a special assembly with the children to explain the new temporary toilet block, ensuring they know exactly what to expect and feel comfortable using it.
- **Year 6 Dismissal:** During Summer, Year 6 children will be dismissed from the 'Old Hall' at the end of the school day.
- **End-of-Day Cones:** The collection cones on the playground will be moved back slightly at home time. This will provide additional room for classes to dismiss safely and give the children a bit more space.

Extra Summer Spaces

We want to make sure the children have plenty of space to play and relax during this transition. Throughout the summer term, we will be providing the children with access to the meadow during break and lunch times. Furthermore, if the British summer weather brings us any particularly warm days, we will also open up the Old Hall for the children to use as a cool, comfortable space.

Thank you as always for your continued support and cooperation as we make Bandon Hill an even better place for our children to learn and grow.
