



### Weather Warning

Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to my update earlier today, we have monitored classroom temperatures this afternoon and current projected forecasts for the following three days (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday)

We will be offering an **optional early collection between 1:00 pm and 1:30 pm on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.**

We are introducing this measure to give families maximum flexibility. It allows children who find the extreme heat particularly challenging the opportunity to head home before the peak afternoon temperatures. However, I must reiterate that **the school remains safe and cool enough to operate**. If you are unable to collect your child early, school will remain open but children will be off the normal timetable, so those children leaving school early will not be disadvantaged in their learning. The children that remain in school will be well looked after until our usual dismissal time.

If you do choose to collect your child early, please read the following collection arrangements **carefully**:

Go to the **Old Hall between 1.00-1.15pm.**



Go to the adult that has your child's Year Group badge on



Give them the name and class of your child



Make your way to the playground where the cones are placed and wait for your child to be handed to you (please be mindful this may take a short amount of time)



Gates will close at 1.30pm
